

## VERO YAHAD SHABBAT SERVICE 1, v2.1

(This is responsive reading, please join in wherever you are, if you will, on all **bold text**, and raise your voice in song where appropriate. The shofar sounds a tekiah *only*. All liturgist's instructions are in parentheses and are NOT read aloud.)

### WE HEAR THE MEDITATION

(ISAIAH 56:1-7) Our Father YHWH tells us: “Keep justice and do right for soon Yahshuati, My Salvation, will come, and My Deliverance will be revealed. Blessed is the one who holds this fast, who keeps the Shabbat, not profaning it, and keeps his hand from doing any evil. Let not the joined stranger say, “YHWH will surely cull me out of his people.” Let not the maimed say, ‘I am a dry tree.’ For YHWH says, “To all those who keep my Shabbatot, who choose the things that please me and hold fast my covenant, I will give a name better than sons and daughters – an everlasting name. Even strangers who join themselves to minister to YHWH and love my name, everyone who keeps the Shabbat and holds fast my covenant, these I will bring to my set-apart mountain, and make them joyful in my house of prayer; for mine will be a house of prayer for all peoples.” (or, the following passages: ISAIAH 58:13–14, LEVITICUS 31:12-18, EZEKIEL 20:3ff)

### WE BLESS YHWH AND HEAR THE QOL SHOFAR

*Bah-ruch ah-ta YH-WH, Eh-lo-hay-nu meh-lech ha-o-lam,  
A-sher kid-sa-nu beh-mitz-voh-taiv vitz-e-vanu lesh-mo-ah kol sho-far.*

**Blessed are you, YHWH our Elohim, Sovereign of the Universe, who sanctifies us by your mitzvot and calls us to hear the qol shofar.**

(The Shofar Master sounds the Tekiah – *one long note.*)

### WE BLESS MESSIAH

*Bah-ruch ah-ta YH-WH, Eh-lo-hay-nu meh-lech ha-o-lam,  
Ah-sher na-tahn la-nu et deh-rech ha-yeh-shu-ah beh-ma-she-ach Yah-shu-a, ahmein!*

**Blessed are you, YHWH our Elohim, Sovereign of the Universe, who has given us the way of escape in Messiah Yahshua. Amein.**

*Ush-av-tem [cha-yim] ma-yim beh-sa-son mi-ma-ay-nai ha-yeh-shu-ah*

**So with joy we draw living water from the springs of deliverance!**

### WE BLESS EACH OTHER

On that day Jacob blessed his grandchildren, he said, “In time to come, the people of Yisrael will use you as a blessing. They will say, ‘May Elohim make you like Ephraim and Menashe’.” (Genesis 48:20)

(For men and boys) *Ye’simcha Elohim ke-Ephraim ve’chi-Menashe!*

**May Elohim make you like Ephraim and Menashe!**

(For women and girls) *Ye’simech Elohim ke-Sarah, Rivka, Ra-chel ve-Lay’ah!*

**May Elohim make you like Sarah, Rivka, Ra-chel and Layah!**

*Ye’varech’echa Elohim ve’yish’merecha.*

*Ya’ir Elohim panav eilecha viy-chuneka.*

*Yisa Elohim panav eilecha, ve’yasim lecha shalom.*

**May Elohim bless you and watch over you!**

**May Elohim shine His face toward you and show you favor!**

**May Elohim be favorably disposed towards you and grant you peace!**

### WE ENTER THE SET-APART HOME

**How lovely are your tents, O Ya'akov, your dwelling places, Yisrael.**

**Through your abundant favor we will enter your home;**

**In awe we will bow down within your Set-apart Sanctuary.**

**We love the home you live in and the place where your radiance resides, We will fall and bow, bending the knee before YHWH our Maker.**

**May our prayers to you be at the appropriate time.**

**In your abundant righteousness, answer us with the truth of your Rescue.**

### WE FAVOR KIN AND TALMIDIM

May it be your will, YHWH our Elohim and Elohim of our fore-parents, that you show favor to us and all our friends and relations; and that you grant us and all in Yisrael a good and long life; that you remember us with good thoughts and blessings; that you consider us with your salvation and your compassion; that you bless us with great gifts and favors; that you make our households complete; that you cause your Presence to dwell among us at all times.

**Privilege us to train up our youth, proselytes, disciples – and all talmidim – in wisdom, understanding, in loving and revering YHWH, in belonging to Yahshua the Anointed One and being committed to him. Let them be people of truth, set-apart for YHWH, to illuminate the world with Torah and tov mitzvot, doing all in the service of YHWH. Hear our supplication right now, and give us the same favor as our spiritual mothers and fathers. Cause our light to shine as a reflection of your face for all ages, so that all Yisrael might be saved. Amein.**

### WE RECITE SHEMA,v-a HAVTAH

(Sing/or say:)

*Shema Yis-ra-el, YHWH E-lo-hey-nu, YHWH E-chad.  
Ba-ruch shem ke-vod mal-chu-to le-o-lam va-ed.*

**Hear O Yisrael, YHWH is our Elohim, YHWH is One.**

**Blessed is the name of his esteemed kingdom forever.**

**And you will love YHWH your Elohim**

**With all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your might,**

**And you will love your neighbor as yourself.**

**Let these words (that I command you this day) be upon your heart.**

**You will teach them diligently to your children  
And speak of them when you sit in your house,  
When you walk upon the path, when you retire, and when you arise.  
And you will bind them for a sign upon your hand  
And let them be frontlets between your eyes.  
And you will write them on the doors and gates of your house,**

WE BLESS THE BLESSED (BAR-CHU)

Bar-chu et YHWH Ha-meh-vo-rahch.

**Bar-uch YHWH ha-meh-vo-rahch leh-oh-lam va-ed.**

Bless YHWH, the Blessed One.

**Blessed is YHWH, the blessed One, for all eternity.**

Remember the Shabbat day to keep it set-apart.

**Six days will you labor and do all your work;**

**but the seventh day is the Shabbat of YHWH your Elohim,  
in it you will not do any work.**

For in six days YHWH made the heaven and the earth, the sea and all that is in them, and rested on the seventh day; that is why YHWH blessed the seventh day and set it apart.

**Speak also unto the children of Yisrael saying: Above all, my Shabbatot you will keep; for this is a sign between me and you throughout your generations, so that you may know that I am YHWH who sanctifies you.**

The Yisraelites are to observe the Shabbat, celebrating it for the generations to come as an enduring covenant.

**It will be a sign between me and the Yisraelites forever, for in six days YHWH made the heavens and the earth, and on the seventh day he abstained from work and rested.**

And it will come to pass that from one new month to another and from one Shabbat to another, **ALL flesh will come to worship before me, says YHWH!**

WE MINISTER SHALOM (SHA-LOM AH-LAY-CHEM)

*Shalom ah-lay-chem, mal-ah-chay ha-sha-rayt, mal-ah-chay el-yon,*

*Mee-meh-lech mal-chay ham-la-cheem, ha-ka-dosh bah-ruch hu.*

*Bo-ah-chem leh-sha-lom, mal-ah-chay ha-sha-lom mal-ah-chay el-yon.*

*Mee-meh-lech mal-chay ham-la-cheem, ha-ka-dosh bah-ruch hu.*

WE GIVE THANKS AND PRAISE

*{Here you may sing psalms, read psalms, give witness. }*

WE HEAR THE WORD AND TESTIMONY

Let the words of my mouth, and the meditation of my heart, be acceptable in your sight, O YHWH, our strength, and our redeemer! *(The appropriate text may here be recited.)*

## **Amein! Let the Prophets Prophecy!**

### THE WORDS OF THE PROPHET (*Before the teaching, the Leader recites:*)

Whenever the ark set out, Moshe said, "Arise, O YHWH, and let your enemies be scattered; and let them that hate you flee before you!" (*Numbers 10:35*)

(*The prophet speaks.*) (*Afterward, the Leader recites from Numbers 10:35:*)

When the ark rested, Moshe said, "Return, O YHWH, to the ten thousand thousands of Yisrael!"

### WE PRAY TOGETHER

(*Prayers and Benedictions, The Amidah, or other may be here, followed by a psalm.*)

(*The Todah Rabah or Communion may be here employed.*)

### WE SING THE SONG OF PEACE "Shalom, My Friends"

**Shalom to you now, shalom, my friends. May YHWH's mercies bless you well, my friends.**

**In all your living and through your loving,**

**YHWH be your shalom, shalom, shalom, YHWH be your shalom.**

### THE LEADER BLESSES

*Yeh-va-reh-cheh-cha YHWH veh-yeesh-meh-reh-cha,*

*Ya-air YHWH pa-naiv ay-leyh-cha vee-chu-neh-cha,*

*Yee-sa YHWH pa-nahv ay-leyh-cha veh-ya-same leh-cha*

*Shalom. B'shem Yahshua ha'Moshiach, sar shalom, amein!*

YHWH bless you and keep you,

YHWH make his face shine upon you and be gracious to you,

YHWH lift up his countenance upon you and give you peace!

In the Name of Yahyshua haMoshiach, Prince of Peace,

**Ahmein!**
